



# **Embedding Safety into Daily Work**

#### **Problem Statements:**

- SCHR continues to see staff and patient harm.
- Not all staff, patients, families, physicians believe they are personally accountable for safety of self and others.
- Just culture and individual accountability needs to be further developed throughout Sun Country Health Region.
- Root cause analysis, patterns and trends of incidents are not always shared nor learnings applied consistently.
- Safety culture and processes are not always aligned and embedded throughout the Region.
- New approaches are needed to ensure the success of replication and streamlining/integration of current safety processes.
- The culture of safety has not been fully adopted at all levels of the organization.
- The current reporting systems do not support timely follow up, timely analysis of trends and patterns nor capacity to escalate concerns throughout the organization.

### **Targets:**

#### By March 31, 2018:

- 100% of SCHR sites will have implemented the elements of Safety Management System and Safety Alert System/Stop the Line.
- 100% of Code 3 /4 and Time Loss Incidents will be investigated using a structured root cause analysis process.
- 18% of all incidents reported will be near misses
- 90% of staff and managers surveyed will indicate that they feel supported and confident to identify safety hazards and take action.
- 95% of patients surveyed will feel comfortable to speak up and stop the line.
- Reduce % of harm by 10% (patient and staff).
- 100% of sites have an audit score of 80% by March 31, 2018.
- 25% decrease in number of WCB claims.
